We welcomed Roz Savage MP, into school this morning.

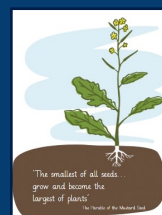
Roz talked to us about her heroic rowing journeys across the oceans to raise awareness about the environment and climate change, and how her passion and commitment led into a career in politics.
