We have been continuing to explore the joys of movement with our Neuro Warriors assessments in the past week. The children absolutely love taking part, as you can see from their smiles!



Through a series of newsletters, I will choose one primitive reflex at a time and explain it in more detail so that you have an idea of the assessment and the programme...

Palmar Reflex:

The Palmar Reflex is the automatic 'grasp' response babies have when something touches their palm. For most children it should fade in infancy, but in some older children it can still show up, making tasks like writing, using scissors, or staying relaxed at a desk a bit harder.

At home, you can support your child by doing simple, playful activities that build hand strength and control; things like climbing and hanging from playground bars, squeezing and releasing play-dough, ball-passing games, finger-tapping patterns, or crawling

games that get the hands working in a coordinated way.
