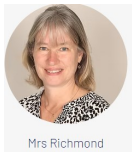


Dear Families,

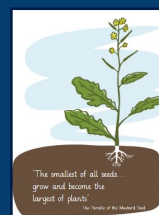

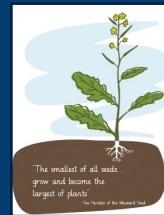


## Atlas Sports
