We have noticed that some children who have Calpol in school are asking for it more regularly; please understand if we phone to double-check with you before administering it; even if you have already completed the form giving permission.

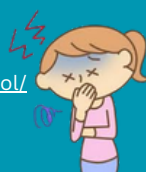
A reminder that if your child has been sick or had diarrhea, they must stay off school for 48 hours after their last episode (i.e. the most recent time they were sick, not the first time).
