Swimming: Parent Survey Responses

Thank you to all those who completed the survey about swimming lessons. Here are some of the messages I received through your responses:

- Whilst many respondents stated that their children have private swimming lessons, over half still believe it is important for children to access lessons in school.
- An overwhelming majority of respondents, 87%, *do not* think that school swimming lessons are unaffordable
- 71% of respondents *do not* see school swimming lessons as a substitute for private lessons and would keep paying separately for these
- Although many respondents believe swimming lessons should be arranged every year in KS2, 81% believe they should only be in place until a child can demonstrate proficiency in the three key skills outlined in the curriculum



I also took the time to read your comments and recognise that some further clarity around costs and funding would be welcomed.

I will use this feedback to plan a new swimming offer for next year; thank you once again for providing some invaluable feedback!

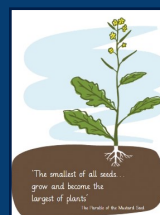

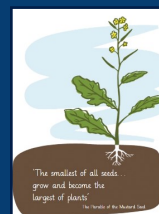
