What a wonderful day we had yesterday celebrating World Book Day!

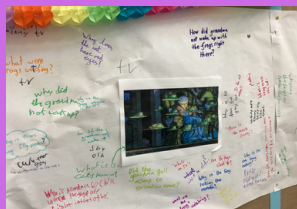
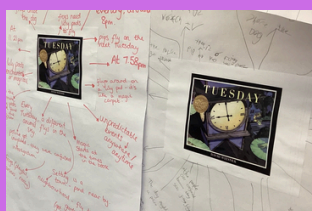
