

Online Safety: Roblox

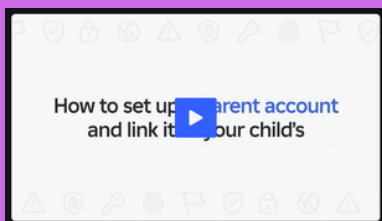


We know that many of our children enjoy exploring the online gaming platform 'Roblox'.

There are lots of reported risks involved in playing this game, including claims of some children being exposed to explicit or harmful content, along with multiple reported allegations of bullying and grooming.

One of the ways you can keep your child safe on Roblox is to set up a parent account, from which you can set limits on the content they see, the games they can play and who they can interact with.

Nits



We have had reported cases of nits in school, including in Year 3. Please could you check your child's hair and treat accordingly.

A reminder, most treatments only get rid of the lice, and the eggs stay on the hair ready to hatch a few days later. Please repeat the treatment until all lice and eggs have gone and check everyone in your family; both boys and girls can get them.

Some over-the-counter treatments are not as effective as they used to be due to the head lice becoming resistant to them; a cheap and effective treatment is combing through the hair with lots of conditioner and a nit comb.

To help prevent your child from catching nits in the future, please keep long hair tied back in a ponytail or plait.
